# RCN Society of Orthopaedic and Trauma Nursing Conference and Exhibition

In 2007, the RCN Society of Orthopaedic and Trauma Nursing is holding its annual conference in Central London for the first time. The event will be held at the prestigious Royal College of Nursing Headquarters in Cavendish Square, London W1, in the heart of the seat of government and sightseeing capital of the United Kingdom. This exciting event aims to bring orthopaedic and trauma nurses across the world together to learn from each other and discuss the issues facing them in an increasingly 'globalised' society.

The scientific committee of the Society of Orthopaedic and Trauma Nursing invites abstract submissions from all professionals who are interested in sharing their skills and knowledge with an international audience. Abstracts for plenary, concurrent, workshop and poster presentations are welcome. We also welcome and encourage both experienced and first time presenters and offer support and advice in the preparation of both abstracts and presentations/posters. The Journal of Orthopaedic Nursing offers prizes for the best presentation and best poster at the conference.

## Guidelines for presentation

Abstracts are invited for plenary, concurrent, workshop and poster presentations.

### Plenary and concurrent presentations.

These will be half an hour in length to include 5 minutes for questions

**Workshops:** These will be approximately 50 minutes in length and provide a more interactive environment between the audience and presenter.

### Posters

These should be visually stimulating in design and convey clear aims and outcomes.

## Abstract format

Abstracts should be a clear and concise summary of the main points of your presentation, indicate clear aims and objectives and demonstrate any auditing and research methods used, if applicable. Abstracts should be

- Typed in single line spacing
- Not exceed 350 words (excluding references)
- Intended learning outcomes and biography
- Not formatted i.e. in grids, using special fonts

Abstracts will be anonymised prior to judging and the selection process will incorporate the following criteria:

- Relevance to orthopaedic and trauma nursing
- Relevance to themes
- Clarity of text
- Potential to influence practice

All references to the author(s) will be excluded from the paper and abstracts when judged 'blind' by the scientific committee to ensure fairness.

Closing date for submissions is 31st May, 2007

## Conference Attendance
